

In 2006, "A Perfect Mr. Re" finished 8th in the nation in the AACAP Awards. for Appaloosas in dressage. In 2007, King of

Broken Hearts, a four year old Appaloosa stallion qualified for the ApHC World Show, trained and ridden almost exclusively by Michelle for Vision Quest Ranch.
